To enrich your English you are advised to follow the instructions and cultivate with yourself:

- 1. Read the article /books /news papers in English available at your home.
- 2. By reading them enhance/enrich your vocabulary and reading skills.
- 3. Try to understand the meaning of new words and phrases; and their usages in particular situations where they are most appropriate.
- 4. Many of you find little time to indulge in going through grammar and application .
- 5. So ,you can utilize this opportunity to be acquainted with the rules and grammar from the book you have had .
- 6. A few lessons in any grammar book as mentioned below must be followed carefully.
- 7. Tense and their usages.
- 8. Conjugation of verbs-regular and irregular /strong and weak –(present—past—past participle).
- 9. Inter-change of parts of speech –(noun-verb-adjective-adverb & vice-versa).
- 10. Phrasal verb/group verb along with single word meaning.
- 11. Use of general preposition /appropriate preposition .
- 12. Voice change –(Active –Passive –Quasi Passive –cognate object –infinitive –complex sentence –imperative sentence –modals -retained object and so on) and their special usages.
- 13. Narration / direct-indirect speech ,narration of vocative , question tag etc. and various use of narration : reporting using indirect narrations. So on..
- 14. Clauses & their kinds [sub clauses] and phrases & their kinds-usages especially prepnl.phrases.
- 15. Sentence--simple--compound--complex--complex-compound & their inter-changes.
- 16. Transformation of sentences in terms of interchange of parts of speech and assertive-interrogative-exclamatory etc.
- 17. Practise translation more and more at home by using good book of translation: a few books are recommended –a) A Golden Book of Translation by P.C.Das., b) Translation Bunch by Duff& Dutt. Available for every class.
- 18. Practise writing skills more as exercises given at the end of every writing lesson in grammar book, test paper, question bank(preferably Ray & Martin) Use your command in Bengali .(F.L.).
- 19. Memorize a good number of Idioms & Proverbs from grammar books or from Appendix given in the end of good Dictionary.
- 20. Always consult good book on grammar (preferably Applied English Grammar and Composition by P.C.Das for Junior class-V to VIII or Senior Level-class-IX to X & above). For advanced learners A Text Book Of Higher English Grammar, Composition and Translation by P.K.De Sarkar, (latest edition) may be advised.
- 21. Always consult a good dictionary –(preferably Everyman's Dictionary or P.C.Das' Dictionary for Eng. To Beng. & Beng. To Eng.-Samsad Dictionary or A.T.Dev's Dictionary). For better pronunciation & Phonetics (IPA)- Daniel Jones' Pronouncing Dictionary may be advised [for especially advanced learners].
